


NOT ENOUGH TAs!!!

There were numerous occasions in my lab section when students had to wait a considerably long time for a TA to become available. I recommend that future iterations of this class be assigned more TAs so that this problem does not occur again.

With 200+ students in his class(which is pretty small for this class)he couldn't personally deal with every problem....but his TA's were great....He could use more though.
